**Supply and Delivery of 1 Lot Fuel, Oil, and Lubricants (FOL) through NEP 2022
 Public Bidding No. PRO10-N-2021-12**

Issued pursuant to Sec. 22.5 of the IRR OF RA 9184 to clarify and/or amend certain provisions in the Bidding Documents issued for the project, considering the issues raised and clarifications made by prospective bidders during the Pre-bid conference held on December 29, 2021, likewise, respond to bidder's written queries received within the prescriptive period for filing.

POLICE REGIONAL OFFICE 10, through the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) issued this Bid Bulletin to amend portions of the bidding documents in connection with the **Supply and Delivery of 1 Lot Fuel, Oil, and Lubricants (FOL) through NEP 2022** as follows:

1. Section II. Instruction to Bidders. Clause 12. Bid Prices								<p>The PE understands that oil prices are volatile by nature. However, paragraph 4.3 of GPPB Circular No. 04-2020 dated September 16, 2020 provides that, "The prescribed documents and/or information in Sections 17 and 23 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 on the form and contents of the PBDs and the eligibility requirements, respectively shall not be revised or amended by the PEs. Thus, request is denied. Please use the bid Price Schedule format prescribed by the latest GPPB issuance which is the GPPB Circular No. 04-2020 dated September 16, 2020 as attached in the Bidding Documents.</p> <p>However, provision of additional column for the discount will be considered provided that the form submitted includes all the mandatory provisions required in the 2016 revised IRR of RA 9184 and its associated issuances and as identified in item 6 of said circular.</p>

If yes, respectfully manifest and inform the procuring entity that the DA to the Gasoline/service station is bound by the terms and conditions of each service station dealer or station owner.</p>	<p>The BAC took note of the Manifestation. However, submission of Affidavit of Undertaking stating that the Supplier shall have fuel station within the 3-kilometer radius of PRO10 Regional Headquarters, Camp Alagar Cagayan de Oro City that is capable of providing services is still required. The name of the franchisee for the aforesaid fuel station and its address shall be indicated.</p>

The supplier's branch/station shall submit a monthly inventory of delivery/storage consumption to the respective end-user of FOL products before the delivery of additional purchases.</p>	<p>Noted.</p>

Special Conditions of the Contract under GCC Clause 1 Incident Services (1) Effect transfer of delivery of Fuel products from one station to another in case the PNP unit /office is transferred/redeployed to another area of operation and/or as requested at no additional cost to the PNP.</p> <p>Manifestation as to the transfer of Delivery Advices from one station to another free of charge except for the actual products delivered to the former gasoline station as the transfer of custody of the product is upon receipt of the actual delivery.</p>	<p>Noted.</p>

For fleet Card, Supplier shall have a wide service stations nationwide capable of providing fleet card access/services and at least one available fuel station which accepts fleet cards within the following areas:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Malaybalay, Bukidnon; b. Cagayan de Oro City; c. Mambajao or anywhere in Camiguin; d. Tubod, Lanao del Norte; e. Iligan City; f. Villanueva, Misamis Oriental; and g. Oroquieta, Misamis Occidental <p>For the Fuel Service Station, it refers to Fuel deliveries to</p>

	Supplier's Fuel Service Station within Region X in the form of Delivery Advices (not Fleet Card Services) that will be issued for the purpose. Supplier shall within twenty-four (24) hours upon receipt of delivery advice from PROCURING ENTITY, confirm acceptance of the delivery schedule requested by PROCURING ENTITY. Moreover, the Procuring Entity has no own tanks for the fuel. Terms and conditions for the said delivery are stated under SCC Clause 1.
